Mount Angel Abbey Retreat House
Lodging and meals

Mount Angel Abbey is pleased to offer lodging and breakfast to guests enjoying the Festival of Art and Wine when we have availability. The rooms are assigned in the order the request is received.

Rooms in the Retreat House are clean, comfortable and simple, in the monastic tradition. Each room has a private bathroom (with shower). Although we provide small soaps, we recommend guests bring their own toiletries for their comfort. Extra towelings are available on the third floor. Guest rooms have small personal fans but are not air-conditioned. The conference (lowest) level is air-conditioned.

Married couples will usually be assigned a room with one double/full bed unless twin beds are requested (and available). Same gender friends and relatives who opt to share a room will be assigned a room with two twin beds. *Please note:* there are a small number of rooms with two twin beds available. Please make sure you tell the office when you make your reservation if you would like one of these room.

As with all retreat houses, we ask that our guests remove the used bedding and put clean bed linen on the bed before departure. This is provided in each guest room (bottom drawer of the desk in the room). This is part of the Benedictine life and is a good opportunity to pray for the next person who will use the room.

On the lowest level of the Retreat House there is a private kitchenette for guests. This room can be accessed with guest room keys and is not open to the public. A refrigerator, microwave and crock-pots help guests prepare their meals. Clear containers are provided for food storage. Dishes, cutlery and some cooking utensils are also provided for the comfort of our guests. A small breakfast bar with stools in the kitchenette allows guests to eat in privacy and the larger social area near to the sink and coffee and tea area has direct access to the garden terrace where guests are welcome to enjoy meals al fresco.

All meals follow a Prayer Service, which you are welcome, and encouraged, to attend. If you have arranged to take breakfast, you will be met by one of the Monks at the main doors to the Abbey Church, at approximately 6.50 a.m..

Schedule of costs:

Double occupancy with breakfast (for two) (Double occupancy indicates two persons per room.)	\$100 per day
Single occupancy with breakfast	\$65 per day
