

Information about Mount Angel Abbey Retreats

Retreat costs are \$167 single occupancy and \$281 double occupancy.

Reservations are confirmed when the \$35 non-refundable/non-transferable deposit per room/per retreat is received. This may be paid by mailing a check [recommended] to Mount Angel Abbey Retreat House, 1 Abbey Drive, Saint Benedict OR 97373. Please note on your check, or a separate piece of paper, the dates of your stay. This will be deducted from the balance due.

If you wish to use Visa, Mastercard or Discover, you may telephone me at 503-845-3025 during office hours (M-F 9:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m.) If I am on the other line, please leave a voice message and I'll return your call.

Please submit names, addresses and phone numbers of all guests wishing to register for retreats.

Fr. Pius X is the Guest Master and will make every effort to be in the Retreat House for registration, or appoint a representative. If Fr. Pius X [or other] is unable to greet you when you arrive, please know that your room key(s) will be in an envelope with your name on it and this will be on the desk in the Retreat House lobby for you to pick up. There will also be a retreat schedule and evaluation form for you. Information will be in the envelope regarding the key code to let you in to the building after the doors are locked at night (appx. 9:00 p.m.).

Registration is at 4.00-5.00 p.m. on the first night of the retreat. You are welcome to arrive as early as 3 p.m.

The retreat formally begins at 5.15 p.m. with vespers, followed by dinner and will conclude the afternoon of the third day, unless otherwise stated.

Meal times are:

Breakfast: 7:00 a.m.
(7.30 a.m. on Sunday)
Lunch 12:15 p.m.
Dinner: 6:00 p.m.

All conferences are held in the Engelberg conference room on the lower level of the Retreat House (unless otherwise stated).

Mount Angel Abbey Retreat House has rooms with one double bed and some rooms with twin beds available for guests. We try to accommodate the needs of our guests as much as possible but there may be times when guests are assigned a room with twin beds. Although you may be assigned a room with twin beds, you will not be asked to share the room.

Each room has a private bathroom (with shower) and we provide the bed linen and bath towel. Although we provide small soaps, we recommend guests bring their own toiletries to make the retreat experience more comfortable. Extra towel is available on the third floor for guests to help themselves. If you need extra bed linen, blankets or pillows, we will be happy to provide them for you.

Please note: guest rooms have small personal fans but are not air-conditioned. The lower level of the Retreat House, where the conference rooms and reading areas are located, is air-conditioned.

As with all Retreat Houses, we ask when a retreat concludes that our guests remove the used bedding and put clean bed linen on the bed (provided in the bottom drawer of the desk. This is an example of Benedictine life and an opportunity to pray for the next guest who will use the room. Used bedding and towels may be put in a pillowcase and left in the room. If you are physically unable to do any of this, please do not concern yourself – employees will be happy to take care of it.

Please leave your room door open when vacating the room and place room key(s) in the return key basket on the desk in the lobby of the Retreat House.

On the first floor, the floor below the main level, there is an ice machine near the outside elevator. If you use the ice machine, please remember to block open the door that leaves the main body of the building. If you forget, you will be locked out but can use the outside elevator to travel to any level.

On the lowest level of the Retreat House there is a private kitchenette for guests. This room can be accessed with guest room keys and is not open to the public. A refrigerator, microwave and crock pots are available for guests to use.

For lost and found items, please check with the Retreat House office at 503-845-3025. All items turned in will be held for one week, after which time items will be donated to a local charitable organization. Mount Angel Abbey Retreat House is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
